Peter Thomas lives in Auckland with his wife Lucy and children Laura (12), Oscar (5) and Rowan (2). He works as a music educator and conductor. He composes for self-indulgence, fun and also to write for the groups which he conducts.

He is Director of Arts and Head of Music at Epsom Girls Grammar School, having previously been Head of Music at Selwyn College. Peter conducts the Epsom Symphonia and Epsom Concert Band. He has previously been the Musical Director of the Auckland Wind Orchestra, the North Shore Youth Orchestra, the Auckland Secondary Schools Orchestra and other groups.

Peter has worked with many other ensembles in a guest conducting capacity, including conducting the Ensemble Philharmonia and Northern Sinfonia. In 2001 he took part as conductor in a masterclass with the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra. In 2003 he was Musical Director for the Epsom Girls / Auckland Grammar production of West Side Story. His studies and conducting have seen him travel to the United States and to Australia.
