ASHLEY HOPKINS CONDUCTOR

After completing a Performance Diploma on Clarinet at the University of Auckland, Ashley joined the Royal New Zealand Navy Band as solo clarinettist where he spent 13 years rising to the rank of Chief Petty Officer in charge of the day-to-day musical activities of the band. Other duties included playing in the highly regarded Navy Big Band on alto and baritone saxophone. During this time he developed an interest in conducting and on leaving the band took up the directorship of the Auckland Secondary Schools Orchestra for four years and conductorship of the North Shore Concert Band for six years.



In 2006, he conducted the Auckland Wind Orchestra at the New Zealand Concert Bands Festival, leading the group to a Gold Award.

Ashley performed for years as an associate player for the Auckland Philharmonia Orchestra and has also played with the NZSO. He has played with many touring shows including *Les Miserables* (twice), *West Side Story*, and *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* as well as visiting performers such as Shirley Bassey and Michael Crawford. Ashley was principal clarinettist in the Auckland Chamber Orchestra for a number of years.

NICOLA WALTON SOLO CLARINET

Nicola has been playing clarinet for twelve years. In 2006, she completed her Bachelor of Music in Performance Clarinet and she's now working towards her Honours degree. She's been a member of the Auckland Wind Orchestra for nearly two years and also plays in two other community orchestras. So far, she's twice been selected to perform in the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra's National Youth Orchestra.

Nicola teaches clarinet, saxophone, flute, trumpet, trombone and percussion and she conducts three junior orchestras. She also plays the bassoon. She hopes to become a secondary school music teacher, as well as continuing to perform and conduct.
