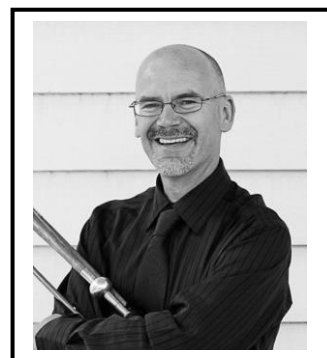

## SOLOIST: PETER REID

Peter Reid studied trumpet at Auckland University then at the Trinity College of Music in London. He free-lanced in the UK and Europe before returning to live in Auckland in 2003. He specialises in the cornetto and the baroque trumpet. In Auckland he plays trumpet for Bach Music, is a founding member of the baroque chamber ensemble Affetto and plays for the Dalewool Brass Band. Other credits include touring with Chamber Music NZ in 2008 with Baroque Voices, playing for Musica Sacra in Wellington, for the Sydney Philharmonia Chamber Orchestra, in Melbourne for La Compania and in Perth for The Musicians' Table. Peter looks forward to playing Monteverdi's Vespers again in Melbourne later this year. In 2013 he played the Arutunian trumpet concerto for the Auckland Symphony Orchestra, and played for Auckland Youth Symphonic Band in his teens.
